## VERB THERE TO BE - SIMPLE PRESENT

# Verb there to be

	Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
Singular	There is	There isn't	Is there ?
Plural	There are	There aren't	Are there?



## **VERB THERE TO BE: SIMPLE PAST**

### Past Simple: There+ To be

	Afirmative	Negative	Interrogative
Singular:	There was	There wasn't	Was there ... ?
Plural:	There were	There weren't	Were there ...?

## Present

**Singular:** There is a boy outside.

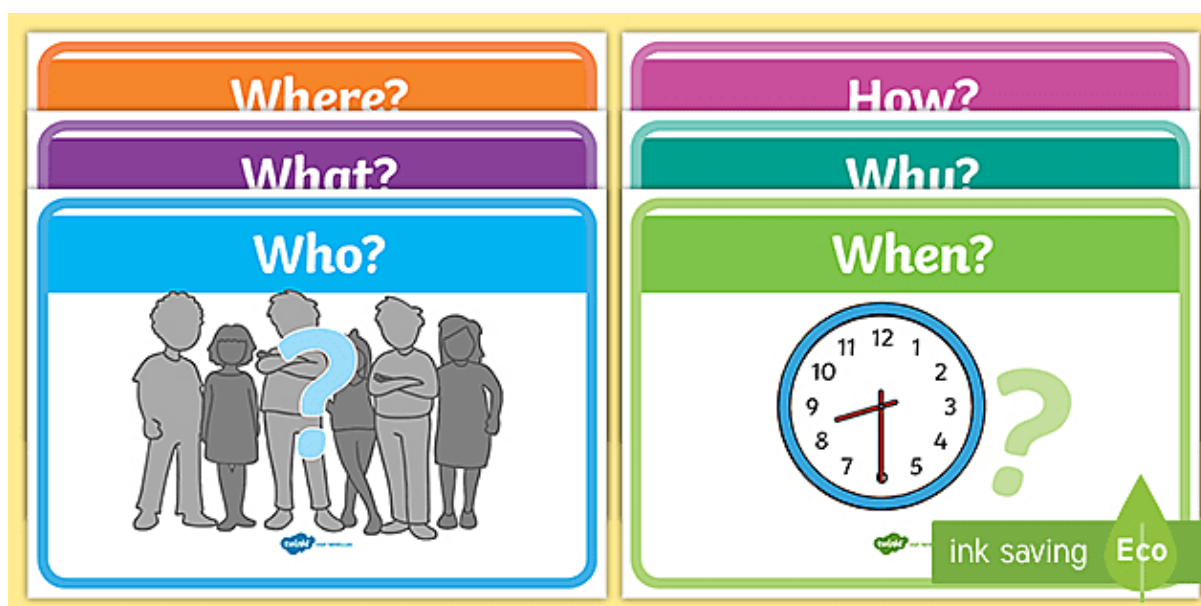
**Plural:** There are some seats left.

## Past

**Singular:** There was a student talking.

**Plural:** There were 10 students talking.

is the reason



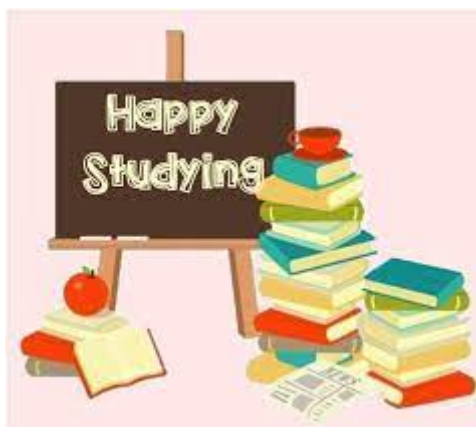
## Examples:

# WH - QUESTIONS

Wh-word	Information about...	Example
<b>What</b>	Things Name Occupations Activities	What is this? It is a book. What is your name? Roberth. What do you do? I am a driver. What is he doing? He's working
<b>Who</b>	People	Who is the director of the school? Carlos Samaniego.
<b>Where</b>	Places	Where is he? In the house.
<b>How</b>	State Form / manner	How are you? I am sad. How is Loja? It is small.
